Routine 1: Follow the speaker - THEORY



Why?

- Easier to understand what is talked about
- You'll remember more
- It is polite and respectful
- It is an essential skill for every job interview and in every career

How?

- Look at the speaker
- Look at the PowerPoint
- Turn to the person who is talking
- Show that you're listening (nod, smile, etc) -> active listening

How not?

- Looking around the room / out of the window
- Looking down
- Looking at other students
- Following the speaker whilst talking or doing something else
- Fiddling with something (i.e. pen) or doodling
