What Are British Values?

Democracy

This is the belief in freedom and equality between all people. It also includes the government working hard to ensure this happens.

There are four main British values.
Do you know what they are?

The Rule of Law

This is the belief that rules and laws should be fair and help everyone to live safely and happily. It also involves everyone working hard to follow the rules and laws.

Mutual Respect and Tolerance of Those with Different Faiths and Beliefs

This is the understanding that we are all different and have different beliefs and values. It is accepting and respecting this and involves no one person or group of people thinking they are more important, deserving or better than anyone else.

Individual Liberty

This is the belief that all people have the right to live and express themselves as they choose. It involves the human rights of all being respected and protected.
