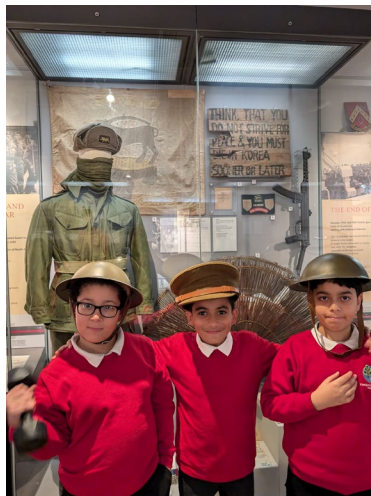


### **SEN coffee morning.**


